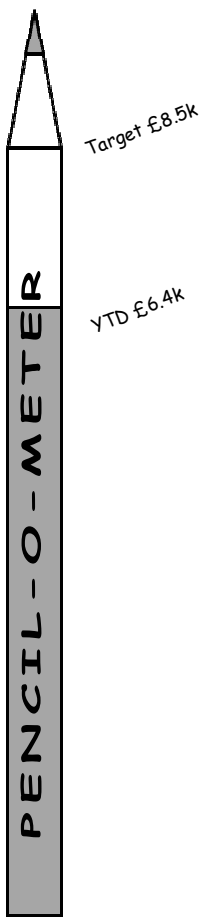

Fundraising Update



As mentioned in the last newsletter, our fund raising target for this year is to match the amount raised last year (£8,500).

Since the last newsletter, the total raised so far this year is nearly £6,400. Of this, £1,242 was raised from the Quiz Night held in March and this included a donation of £586 as a result of the Barclay's company matched giving scheme.

But what's happening with this money?

A digital camera is available in school for each class to share. Not surprisingly, this is in great demand and so we were pleased to be able to fund the school's request for each class to have their own. These have been delivered and no doubt will be used a great deal both in and outside of school.

We are also working with Miss Longmire and Mrs Ramiz on the school's development plan for the Reception class's outside area. Further details will follow on this when they have been finalised.

Don't forget that we're collecting these vouchers. Drop them in the boxes by the Office.

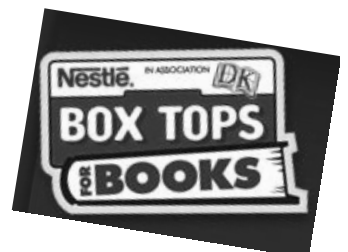
