Dear Parents,

We are really looking forward to the forthcoming Year 6 trip to Bude and I am, therefore, writing to confirm timings and other final details.

The children will need to be at school by 7.00am for a 7.15am departure, to arrive in Bude by approximately 1pm. No school uniform is required, they should come to school in their own clothes. Pupils are asked to bring one main piece of luggage, and they MUST be able to carry it themselves. Pupils should bring a snack, lunch, and a bottle of water with them for the journey (as always, no fizzy drinks, sweets or chocolates, no cans or glass bottles please). All other meals are provided.

In addition to the original list it would be great if they could also bring a small backpack/gym bag and a large plastic carrier bag/bin liner (for wet swimwear). Please check the weather forecast beforehand and pack accordingly.

May I emphasise the importance of naming all clothing, toiletries and belongings.

As mentioned in the original letter

- medication must be in a named container with details of the dosage and time to be administered
- digital cameras are allowed, but we must stress that these will NOT be the responsibility of the school: they will be the responsibility of your child. You may wish to consider a disposable camera for this trip
- pupils may **NOT** bring any sprays (deodorants or hair products)
- they will not require any money
- they are not to bring any electrical items such as personal music players, iPads, iPods, hairdryers, hair straighteners or mobile phones
- **if any mobile phone is brought on the school trip it will be immediately confiscated**

We will confirm our arrival by ParentMail, update you daily of our news and contact you should we have any concerns. The school mobile no is 07340 683058. This should be used for emergencies only.

We will be returning on Friday 28th September, leaving Bude at 1pm and expect to arrive at school around 6.30pm (tbc by ParentMail when we are en route).

If your child suffers from travel sickness, please give them medication in plenty of time and also give me a repeat dose (with instructions) for the return journey in a clearly marked envelope. **All medication must be given to me on Monday morning – not kept in your child's care.**

This is a wonderful opportunity for the class and a trip they will treasure for a long time to come. If you have any last minute queries, please don't hesitate to contact me.
