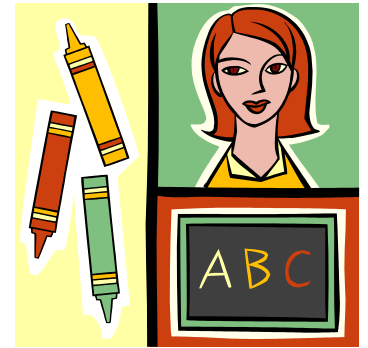

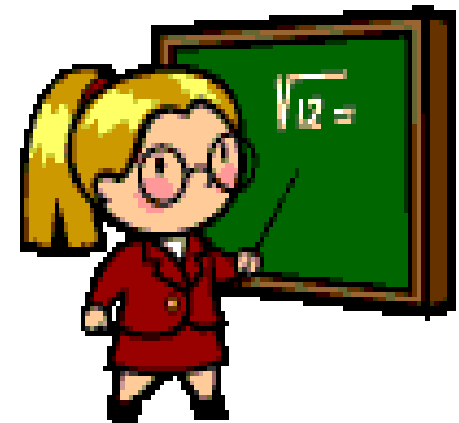
Class Morning Routines



- ▶ Book bags are emptied (named please, try to discourage the use of too many key fobs, etc) .

KS1 SATS 2018/2019



- ▶ The children's progress will be measured by a process of continuous assessment.
- ▶ Teacher assessment will determine the overall step children are awarded.
- ▶ All tests are merely a guideline (statutory for all children to sit for these key tests)

Continuous Assessment

- ▶ To know exactly where children are at in their learning
- ▶ Use of targets to move them onto the next step



Changes to SATs

- ▶ All children will now have to sit for a Spelling and Grammar paper(SPAG)
- ▶ Reading is more complex as all children will need to read a long text that may not have any pictures to guide them.
- ▶ Maths paper – Paper A(Counting and Calculating) and Paper B(Mathematical Reasoning)
- ▶ Information evening in Spring term – TBC

Reading

- ▶ Books are changed 3 times a week – Mon , Wed and Fri but please send book/s in every day. If your child has read their book, then read it again.
- ▶ **Guided Reading** –every week Teacher and TA will hear as many children read each week(we use different books/texts to the reading scheme).
- ▶ Reading assessments are ongoing and discrete.
- ▶ Your comments – please use their Reading record book for observations (Not for general communication where possible)



Homework

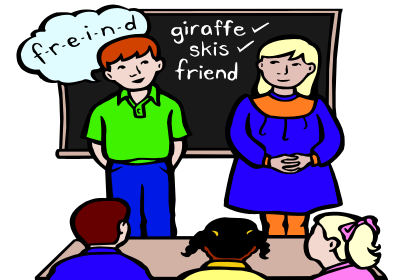
- ▶ Monday – Come and See (due in on Thursday)
- ▶ Thursday – Maths (due in on Monday)
- ▶ Friday – Spelling test.

(Please use homework folder to protect their work)



Spelling/Grammar Homework

- ▶ A new spelling pattern will be introduced and children will have a list of ten spelling words.
- ▶ Children will be given a practice sheet so that they can practise their spelling at home.
- ▶ Sometimes words will be repeated as the need to be practised again.
- ▶ They will also be tested on their words **every Friday** as part of our continuous assessment process.



Reminders

- ▶ PE kits – named please, don't forget shorts and long trousers. They will have PE every Wednesday. Planet Sports on Thursdays.
