BOCKETTS FARM: TUESDAY 25TH JUNE 2019

Dear Parents,

As part of the children's work this term, a visit has been arranged to Bocketts Farm in Leatherhead. This is a family-run working farm which offers hands-on experience of the farm and a tractor ride. We will be leaving school at 9.15am and returning to school by 3.30pm.

CLOTHING: Children should wear their PE kit: green T-shirt and navy tracksuit trousers, **NOT shorts**. Please ensure that your child comes to school wearing their Wellington boots with their school shoes in a **NAMED** plastic bag. If the weather looks chilly, they should also have their green school sweatshirt and a lightweight waterproof.

FOOD: A packed lunch will be required, and this should be brought in **lunch boxes please, NOT a plastic bag**. Drinks to be in a cardboard carton or plastic bottle - *not glass bottles or cans*, and no chocolate or sweets. They will also need a snack to be eaten on arrival.

COST: The cost will be £21 per child; this amount can be paid online via Parentmail or cash/cheque (payable to 'St Edmund's School Fund') to the school office. **Payment should be received in school by Tuesday 18th June please.**

If your child suffers from travel sickness, please give him/her something to treat this before coming to school. If any children are allergic to animals/fur or nuts, please inform us.

Please let the school office know if you have an alternative emergency contact number for that day which is different from the one held on the school records.

Under the terms of the Education Reform Act this cost is met by voluntary contributions from you, the parents. However, if your child receives free school meals, or have other financial issues, assistance may be given. Please contact Mrs Higgins or Mrs Tod within seven days of the date of this letter to discuss.
