Here are lots of phonics games to practice your sounds.

For this week, the children should focus on the different ways of doing 'oi' (phase 3) and 'oy' (phase 5). I have attached lots of activities to practice these alternative versions of the same sound.

Handwriting

I have attached some handwriting sheets so the children can practice their cursive handwriting.

I have put another rainbow handwriting activity on Seesaw. They can focus on writing words with the alternative 'oi' and 'oy'.

Literacy Writing

This week, some strange creatures have left something in our classroom - an alien egg. They send us a letter and took pictures in our classroom (go through Lesson 1 PowerPoint first). The PowerPoint starts by talking about exclamation marks and then it is a surprise. There is a message from the 'aliens' and then some funny pictures afterwards. I hope they enjoy them.

Get the children to look through the pictures and get them to discuss the different aliens etc.

First, the children will need to draw pictures in each box to plan their ideas about the aliens (Lesson 1)

Then, they need to write the answers to the questions about the aliens.

I hope the children enjoy these funny pictures and enjoy writing about the aliens' adventures.

They could also:

- Write small descriptions about the aliens
- Draw what they think the baby alien in the egg might look like.

Grammar


To continue their learning about using the connective word 'and', get the children to write sentences about their day.

e.g. I ate breakfast and it was yummy!

e.g. I did some writing and I worked really hard.

Handwriting

The children are going to focus on the 'caterpillar letters' and in particular 'a' and 'c'. The children can practice these in a cursive style.



Maths

Our topic is Number and Place Value to 100.


This week, we will be focusing on recognising, writing, partitioning and comparing numbers to 100.

1. Identifying and writing numbers to 100. The children can sing along to the 'Hundreds' song on YouTube to start. The activity is getting the children to fill in the numbers on the 100 grid. Go through first and then the activity afterwards.
2. Partitioning Numbers to 100. This is for the children to understand how many tens and ones are in numbers to 100. The children need to count how many diennes there are to show the right number. The next activity is for the children to draw the diennes for the numbers. I have attached a PowerPoint to go through first and then the activity afterwards.

Here are diennes:



3. Comparing numbers to 100. The children will use the crocodile symbols to state whether a group of objects is 'greater than' or 'less than' the other group. The activities are that the children can count the diennes and then decide which symbol to use. The other are problem solving activities.

Cosmic Yoga for kids on YouTube is a great way of keeping active!


If you haven't started already, Joe Wicks does fantastic exercises every day at 9am on his YouTube. It is hard work but so much fun! Everyone can join in.

Circus Themed



Topic

1. The children can watch the video about painting a clown face. Then the children can look through the PowerPoint at different clown expressions. For the activity, the children are going to be making clown masks.



2. Look through the PowerPoint about the different elements of a modern-day circus. Then the children can create their own circus ring by cutting out different pictures and sticking them in the correct format. Underneath, the children can complete the sense poem.

Science

This week, the children will be thinking about the season 'Summer'. Look through the PowerPoint about moving from Spring into Summer. Get the children to draw a picture of themselves and dress in summer clothes with a summer background.

Paddington went on another adventure and made his own house. Perhaps, the children could write about his adventures.
