

I have attached some real words and nonsense words for the children to practice.


Handwriting

The children are going to be focusing on their cursive handwriting by practicing the letters:



Literacy Writing

This week, the children are going to be focusing on the book; 'If I ran the circus'.



On the PowerPoints, there is a link to the story.

1. The children need to listen to a part of the story. Then, they need to make a set of rules for the circus performers and the audience.
2. Then the children need to listen to more of the story. They need to write a letter to the queen, asking for her to come and watch their circus.

Maths

2. The children will need to discuss days of the week. They need to solve the problems.
3. The children will need to discuss months of the year. They will need to order the months in the right order.

Cosmic Yoga for kids on YouTube is a great way of keeping active!


If you haven't started already, Joe Wicks does fantastic exercises every day at 9am on his YouTube. It is hard work but so much fun! Everyone can join in.
