Dear Parents,

Welcome to Reception! – it was wonderful to have all our new Reception children join us this week. The children have settled in really well. Welcome to all our new St Edmund's families!

Special Mass for the blessing of the new school buildings – you are welcome to attend a special Mass to be celebrated by Bishop Richard Moth at 10am on Monday in the school hall. This will be a lovely reminder of how blessed we are to have had such improvements made to our school, which will benefit us all.



Dinner money – dinner money (KS2 only) for the first half of this term is £86.40. It is Surrey County Council policy that <u>dinners should be paid for in advance</u>. Also, please note that if you wish to change your child's dinner arrangements, two weeks' notice must be given in writing to the school office.

"Meet the Teacher" – this will be held on Monday for Years 1-6 (3.25pm and 3.55pm) and on Monday 25th September for Reception (3.20pm). This is an opportunity for you to meet your child's teacher and find out more about what they will be learning this year. There are two identical sessions per class for those with more than one child here. Just go to your child's classroom after pick-up. Children of school age can be left in the hall where they will be supervised by Mrs Higgins. If you cannot attend, important information will be sent to you and also put onto the school website under School Information and then Meet the Teacher.



Choir – it is lovely that so many children enjoy singing and have wanted to join our Key Stage Two choir this term. Our first session this week went really well, though please note that there is NO choir on Monday of next week due to the Meet the Teacher meetings. Also, a further Microsoft Form was sent out to all parents of children who come to choir, with a **deadline of today for completing it**. There remains a number of parents who have not yet completed it for us.

No dogs – please be reminded that dogs are not allowed on any part of the school premises. We do thank you for your attention to this.



INSET DAYS – please note that the INSET day in March is not Wednesday 13th March, but **Friday 15th** March 2024. Also, there is a further INSET day of which you need to make a note: Monday 3rd June 2024.

Celebration of Grandparents – this year's Celebration of Grandparents will be at 2.15pm on Friday 29th September. This will take the form of a short performance by each class, followed by light refreshments. This is usually an extremely popular event. Therefore, we are only able to accommodate grandparents. If you are bringing grandparents, you can drop them at school. We do ask that you, the parents, **do not come into the hall with them**.



Royal Surrey Community Day 23 Sept 10am to 3pm – children and their parents are invited to explore the work of the Royal Surrey County Hospital as per the details going out with this newsletter. A wonderful opportunity to meet doctors and nurses and to ask them lots of questions!
