

- complete and return (to the school office) the **school SIF** which can be obtained from the school office or downloaded from the school website (School Information/Admissions then scroll down to the PDF called 'St Edmund's Godalming SIF 2024-2025').
- complete the **Surrey County Council online** application

- Mass and Lunch for the Centenary of Consecration of St Edmund's Church This Sunday we welcome Bishop Richard to preside at 10.30am Mass at St Edmund's Church (NB there is no 8.45am Mass, and 6pm Vigil Mass will be at St Joseph's).

 Parking is in the town car parks (South Street and Croft Road) or along Summerhouse Road (and then walk down the steps) or at Godalming College.

 Children's Liturgy during 10.30am Mass is in the parish room but please register via the Calendar as there are 12 spaces. Lunch is in the Main Hall at Godalming College (Tuesley Lane, GU7 1RS) where there is plenty of parking. The Hall will not be open for dropping off food before Mass; please bring your contribution to the cold buffet with you to the lunch.
