

Key Priorities

Ensure that we have consistent high standards of teaching across the school to support best progress of all children.

- 1. Focus on marketing to try and ensure reception class is full in 23/4 and beyond.
- 2. Implement and embed Master Readers to improve reading outcomes in KS2.
- Implement systems so that progress and attainment data for all vulnerable children are tracked and known by all staff.
- 4. Ensure that SEND best practice guidance shared at SENCO meetings is in place eg SEND on a page for governance meetings, implement Edukey provision mapping, provision for bottom 20% by subject etc.
- 5. Implement monitoring and evaluation systems to ensure the quality of the foundation curriculum continues to build on the improvements made this year.
