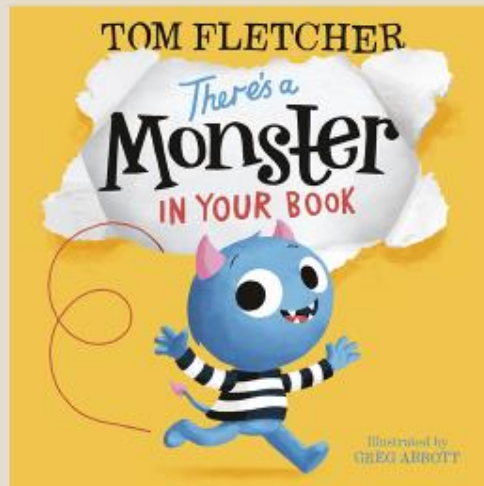


This is our book of the week...
