Holy days, like holidays, are times for celebrating and enjoyment. We relax from ordinary life and think about other things.

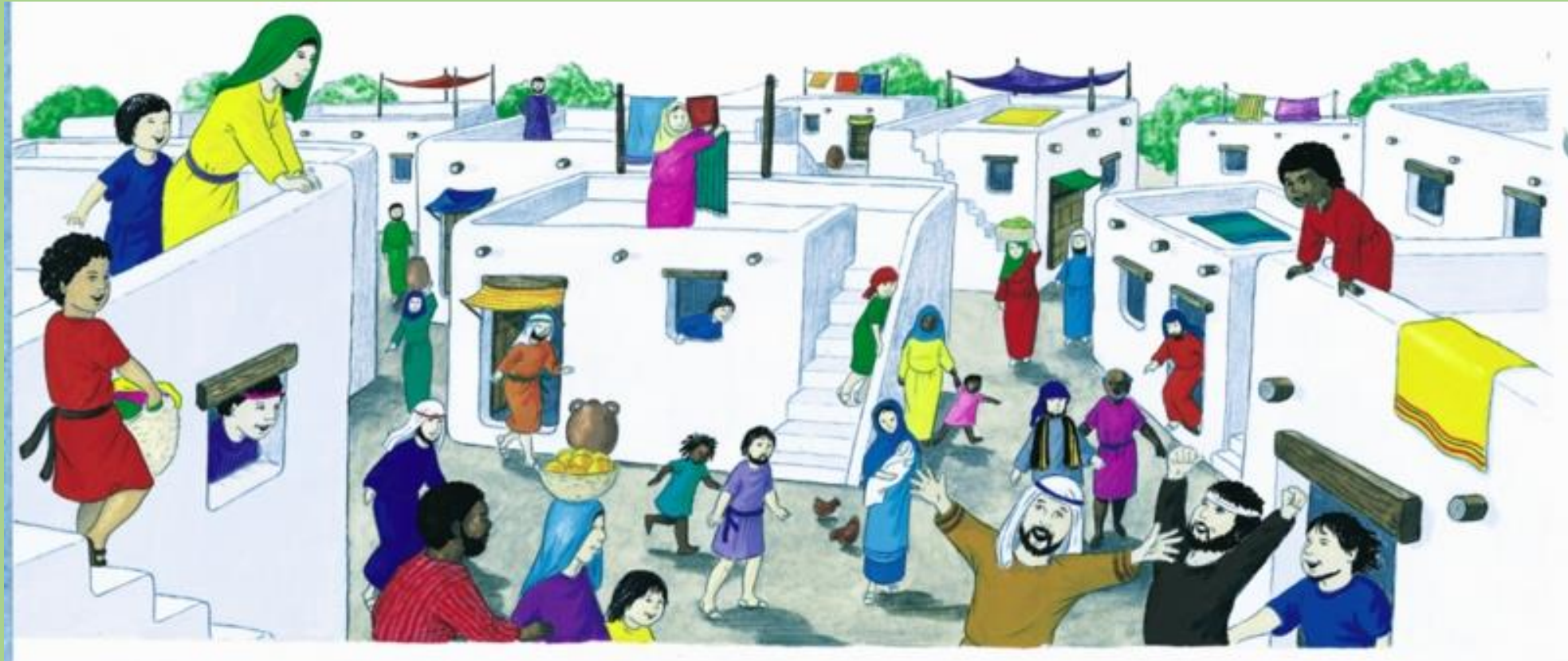


Holy days are special times for thinking about the life of Jesus and about God the Creator's love and care for us.
